## Certificate III in Hospitality



This qualification reflects the role of skilled operators who use a range of well-developed hospitality skills. They use discretion and judgement and have a sound knowledge of industry operations. They work with some independence and under limited supervision and may provide operational advice and support to team members.

### Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements.  
Must be employed in a relevant position if undertaking through a traineeship program.

### Course Requirements

15 units of competency are required to complete this qualification, including 8 core units and 7 elective units. This qualification has a 24 month term for full-time employees and a 36 month term for eligible part-time employees under a traineeship arrangement.
