This qualification reflects the role of workers in the community and/or residential setting who follow an individualised plan to provide person-centred support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or some other reason. Work involves using discretion and judgement in relation to individual support as well as taking responsibility for own outputs.

Entry Requirements

Learners must be 18 years of age or older (with the exception of School Based trainees). Must be employed in a relevant position if undertaking through a traineeship program. Health workers and learners undertaking work placement in NSW Health facilities must comply with the assessment, screening and vaccination requirements and will be required to undertake a National Criminal Record Check before commencing work or work placement in NSW Health facilities.

Course Requirements

13 units are required to complete this qualification, including 7 core and 6 elective units. This qualification has a 12 month term for full-time employees and 24 months for eligible part-time employees under a traineeship arrangement.

To achieve the Qualification, the Learner must have completed at least 120 hours of work experience as detailed in the Assessment Requirements of the Units of Competency.
