This qualification reflects the role of support workers who complete specialised tasks and functions in aged services, either in residential, home or community based environments. Workers will take responsibility for their own outputs within defined organisation guidelines and maintain quality service delivery through the development, facilitation and review of individualised service planning & delivery.

Entry Requirements

Learners must be 18 years of age or older.

Must be employed in a relevant position if undertaking through a traineeship program.

Health workers and learners undertaking work placement in NSW Health facilities must comply with the assessment, screening and vaccination requirements and will be required to undertake a National Criminal Record Check before commencing work or work placement in NSW Health facilities.

Course Requirements

18 units are required to complete this qualification, including 15 core units and 3 elective units. This qualification has a 24 month term for full-time employees under a traineeship arrangement. To achieve the Qualification, the Learner must have completed at least 120 hours of work experience.

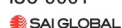
