This Qualification reflects the role of workers in a range of community settings and client's homes, who provide training and support in a manner that empowers people with disabilities to achieve greater levels of independence, self-reliance, community participation and wellbeing. Workers promote a person-centred approach, work without direct supervision and maybe required to supervised and/or coordinate a small team.

### Entry Requirements

Learners must be 18 years of age or older.

Must be employed in a relevant position if undertaking through a traineeship program.

Health workers and learners undertaking work placement in NSW Health facilities must comply with the assessment, screening and vaccination requirements and will be required to undertake a National Criminal Record Check before commencing work or work placement in NSW Health facilities.

### Course Requirements

14 units are required to complete this qualification, including 11 core units and 3 elective units. This qualification has a 24 month term for full-time employees and under a traineeship arrangement. To achieve the Qualification, the Learner must have completed at least 120 hours of work experience.
