QUALIFICATION RULES

For a Certificate III in Agriculture at least 12 of the units of competency presented for this qualification must relate to agricultural procedures, activities or contexts. In addition, at least 80% of the total number of units selected to make up this qualification must be aligned clearly to Certificate III outcomes.

Note: Three units may be selected from other endorsed Training Packages on Access Group Training's scope. Units selected must be aligned to Certificate II, III or IV outcomes and must be relevant to work undertaken in the rural sector.
